TOURNAMENT RULES

- 1. THE FOLLOWING RULES PLUS USBC RULES WILL GOVERN ALL PARTICIPANTS IN THIS TOURNAMENT.
- 2. This is a (optional) 4-person team, singles, doubles and all events tournament open to all MS USBC bowlers age 50 and above with an average (21 game minimum) in the state of Mississippi. Entrants must have reached their 50th birthday on or before December 1, 2017. Driver's license or proof of age will be required. Six games, (3) Singles and (3) Doubles must be bowled to be eligible for the Nationals. (Team not eligible for Nationals). Reserved entry closing date is November 15, 2017. Tournament dates are December 2-3 and 9-10, 2017. Optional 4-person team will be conducted. (Not required for all events National eligibility.)
- 3. There will be a minimum one cash prize awarded for each (8) entries except All Events Handicap which will be one prize for each (10) entries.
- 4. All prizes will be on handicap basis. Each division winner will be determined by <u>ALL EVENTS</u>, which is the total of doubles and singles (first time bowled) and will be recognized as the Mississippi State Champion.
- 5. EACH CLASS HANDICAP WINNER, EXCEPT 4-PERSON TEAM WILL RECEIVE A PAID ENTRY TO THE USBC 2018 NATIONAL SENIORS TOURNAMENT. IT WILL BE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF EACH STATE CLASS WINNER TO NOTIFY, AS SOON AS POSSIBLE, THE TOURNAMENT MANAGER SHOULD THIS BOWLER NOT BE ABLE TO BOWL IN THE NATIONALS.
- 6. Ties:
 - (A) Ties in singles, doubles or all events will reflect co-position finish and prizes will be combined and divided.
 - (B) National Class Ties will be broken by the high handicap series score bowled in the singles event. If there is still a tie, the finalist will be determined by the highest handicap game in singles and then doubles until the tie is broken.
- 7. Handicap in each event will be computed on a basis of 80% of the difference between each average and 220. It shall be each bowler's responsibility to verify the accuracy of their reported average on the entry form.

 Maximum allowed handicap per event is 180.
- 8. Entrants will use their highest USBC sanctioned winter (use summer, if no winter) league average based on a minimum of 21 games for the 2016-2017 season. If no 2016-2017 average, use highest current season average of at least 21 games as of closing date of entry. All others bowl scratch. NOTE: BOWLERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR VERIFICATION OF HIS/HER OWN AVERAGE.
- 9. The schedule as published must be adhered to. Should any entry fail to appear on time to bowl, the entry fee will be forfeited. An entrant arriving late will be permitted to bowl, with score to count beginning with frame being bowled, previous frames will be scored as zero.
- 10. All eligible participants must display their USBC Individual membership cards or purchase an affiliate USBC membership card for \$26.00.
- 11. Substitutions in each event are allowed, provided the Tournament Manager is notified and the average of the substitute is certified. SUBSTITUTION IN ALL EVENTS IS NOT ALLOWED IF EITHER ORIGINAL BOWLER OR SUBSTITUTE HAS BOWLED IN THE TOURNAMENT.
- 12. Automatic scorers will be the official records of scores: Errors in scoring must be reported as they occur.
- 13. MULTIPLE PARTICIPATION IS ALLOWED. When a bowler competes more than once the first appearance shall count toward all events score. A bowler may cash only once in the singles event. The same four and two man team cannot place more than once in the prize list.
- 14. Entries will be scheduled on a First come, First Served Basis. All games may be scheduled in one day. If the number of entries require it, the tournament may be extended. MANAGEMENT RESERVES THE RIGHT TO RE-RATE OR REJECT ANY ENTRY PRIOR TO BOWLING.
